


# EDITING PHOTOS IN PHOTOSHOP

## OPENING THE PHOTO IN PHOTOSHOP


Control+click ->Open With -> Adobe Photoshop

## CROPPING AN IMAGE

Not all images need to be cropped. You may want to consider cropping the image if there is not a clear subject or focal point, if the image is boring because it is too centered, or if you want to eliminate distracting background objects.

1. Select the crop tool. 
2. Click and drag the crop tool to select the part of the image you want to remain.
3. Adjust the edges by dragging them.



4. When you are happy with your selection, click the selection (black arrow tool) in the toolbar. 
5. A window will pop up asking if you want to crop your image. Select "crop."
